Overview

RoadMap - an affiliate member of IASP since 2015 - is planning to organize a two-day training workshop event in the period 21 - 23 October 2017.

Justification of the workshop

- Many initiatives have been launched by different organizations inside Sudan, namely some universities and banks, to establish incubators that can serve different industry sectors.
- 2. The absence of a customized disciplined approach to design, plan for and manage the incubators. In fact, there seems to have a problem in realizing the concept & hence implementing it.
- 3. The urgent need for introducing the incubators model as a first step towards spreading the culture of science and technology parks (STPs) in Sudan as a main tool for fostering innovation and contributing to the national economy.

Workshop Objectives

- 1. To introduce the concept of STPs and their importance to the country, and promote the IASP inside Sudan as a leading global network for STPs and areas of innovation.
- 2. To provide the required knowledge, tools and skills to design, build and operationalize business and technology incubators.

- 3. To help in unifying the model used for establishing incubators in Sudan based on international best practices.
- 4. To contribute to the increasing national efforts directed to building a national system of innovation.
